Announcement for ISA Senior Fellowships for the period July – December 2016

**Submission of application:
October 6, 2015 to December 1, 2015 (Deadline 11.00 pm December 1, 2015)**

In accordance with its institutional aims and towards the fostering of the internationalisation and didactic-scientific transversality of the University of Bologna, the ISA Istituto di Studi Avanzati, in co-operation with the University Departments, hosts every year sixteen Visiting Fellows for a duration of one to three months, in periods of the academic year that allow for fruitful interaction with the University facilities and with its students. The Fellowship period must be continuous and cannot be divided.

ISA offers to Fellows:

- **Accommodation** - a studio-apartment suitable for two people in the Residence Terzo Millennio Bologna (<http://www.rtmliving.com/bologna/it/index.php>), via Miliani 7/2. The residence is in the Borgo Panigale district, at around 8,5 Km from the city center, well-connected by public transport to the city center and to the University area.
- **Fellows room** - a common room equipped for study and reading located at Palazzo Paleotti, via Zamboni 25.
- **Contribution for expenses** (travel, transports and food) - a total amount of 800 Euros for EU citizens and 1,100 Euros for non-EU citizens.

Announcement of selection of eight for senior visiting fellowship

Art. 1 - Professors and Researchers with a permanent active position at the University of Bologna are invited to present to the Istituto di Studi Avanzati of the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna proposals for Senior Visiting Fellows for stays from a minimum of thirty days to a maximum of ninety days uninterruptedly in the period July- December 2016. The Fellowship period must be continuous and cannot be divided.

Applications must be uploaded **no later than 11.00 pm December 1, 2015** at the following link <https://personale.unibo.it>. The link can also be accessed from the ISA Web site www.isa.unibo.it.

The application must be accompanied by the following documents, which shall be uploaded:

- I. **curriculum vitae**
- II. **list of publications**

III. a **letter of invitation and support, signed by the Proposer**, describing the scientific profile of the Senior Visiting Fellow and his/her research project to be developed in Bologna.

Art. 2 - All the elements presented in Art. 1 will be evaluated by the ISA Board, who will then select the best eight applicants.

The criteria of selection are:

<i>scientific excellence of the applicant</i>	30%
<i>quality of the research proposal</i>	40%
<i>relevance of an ISA residency</i>	30%

The results of the selection will be communicated – by publication on the website www.ias.unibo.it and also by e-mail to the University of Bologna inviting Professors – at the end of the selection procedure on January 30, 2016.

Art. 3 Acceptance of the Fellowship must be communicated within 15 days by sending an email to isa.coordination@unibo.it. Renounce must be communicated by email to isa.coordination@unibo.it within 15 days from the receipt of the assignment letter so that the Fellowship position can be offered to other candidates following in the ranking. In case of renounce beyond the above-mentioned terms, under motivated and documented reasons, the ISA Board will evaluate the possibility to offer the Fellowship to the following candidate in the ranking.

Art. 4 Entry and residence in Italy of the Fellows will be regulated in accordance with Italian law and the ordinances of the local authorities. In case a Visa is required, ISA will provide the necessary documents to the Fellow and his/her proposer, who will then complete the procedure required to obtain a Visa.

Art. 5 The Institute will confer injury and third-party liability coverage (RCT).

The Fellowship does not confer the right to social security or national health service coverage. Fellows are required to take out appropriate medical, accident and civic liability insurance, as established by University regulations.

Art. 6 – The contribution for expenses will be delivered only after the completion of the agreed period of Fellowship and under the condition of filling in and deliver to the ISA administration office all the forms and documents required and described in the section dedicated to Senior Visiting Fellows on the ISA website www.ias.unibo.it .

Art. 7 - This announcement will be available on the website www.ias.unibo.it until the closing date of application.
